Founded in Osaka, Japan, in 1928, Minolta is perhaps best known for making the first integrated autofocus 35mm SLR camera system. In addition to cameras, Minolta was a worldwide manufacturer of digital and film cameras, camera accessories, photocopiers, fax machines, laser printers, industrial radiometric instruments, planetarium projection equipment, some of the industry's first 3D scanners, and other optical instruments and devices before merging with Konica in 2003. The brand stands for **Precision Optics, Image Quality and Innovation.**
